**For its 21st edition, the L'Europe autour de l'Europe festival presents the Prix Sauvage Corto competition, dedicated to short films and emerging European filmmakers.**

This year, the selection includes **28 films** from **Germany, Bulgaria, China, Spain, Estonia, France, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Moldova, Poland, Romania, the United Kingdom, Serbia, Slovakia and Turkey.**

The screenings will take place at the cinema **Studio des Ursulines** on **April 4 and 5 avril 2026.**
